

Guidelines for Use of the Display Area in the JICC

The JICC maintains the exhibition display area as a space for artists or organisations to display artistic works related to Japanese culture. The presence of exhibit pieces does not constitute sponsorship or endorsement by the Consulate-General of Japan.

Placement of art work in the JICC is subject to the following conditions:

1. The works of art offered for display in the JICC must take into consideration general standards of decency and respect for the diverse beliefs and values of the local community. The JICC does not permit the display of works which are offensive to decency, or which are of an obscene or immoral nature.
2. Each exhibitor is responsible for the installation and removal of the art work. There are no storage spaces available.
3. Exhibitors are not permitted to place in the JICC any advertisement which solicits monetary donations or advocates consideration of any product or service sold by any business, charitable enterprise, or individual. Exceptions may be made for special events and fundraising campaigns approved by the JICC.
4. The JICC will publicize scheduled displays via the JICC Friends News and the JICC website. Exhibitors should notify the JICC if they intend to conduct their own publicity.
5. The JICC display cases should be left in the condition they were found.
